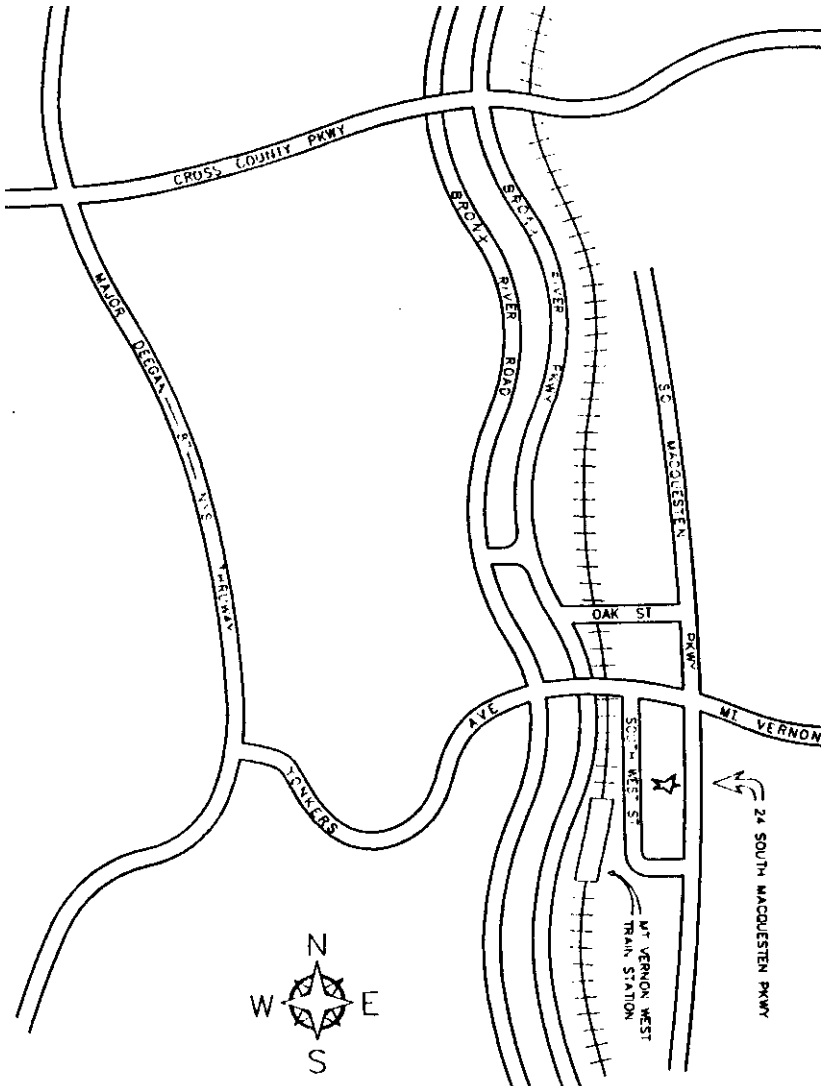


Directions to Hyperlink, Inc.



From The George Washington & Triboro Bridges: 87/Major Deagan/NY State Thruway (North), to "Yonkers Ave" exit, (Right) onto Yonkers Ave., continue approx. 2 miles, (Yonkers Ave. becomes Mt. Vernon Ave.), cross over Bronx River and under train tracks, make first right onto "South West Street" #35 is the fourth building on the left. Our parking lot is on the left, after the tan brick building, and just before #35.

From The Throgs Neck & Whitestone Bridges & The Bronx: 95/Cross Bronx Expwy, exit Rose Dale Ave for "Bronx River Pkwy" (North), "Oak Street", right onto Oak St., make first right onto "North West Street", cross over intersection onto "South West Street", #35 is the fourth building on the left. Our parking lot is on the left, after the tan brick building, and just before #35.

From The Tappan Zee Bridge & 87 (South: 87 (South) to exit #4 "Mile Square Road", straight on service road one mile, (Left) onto Yonkers Ave., continue approx. 2 miles, (Yonkers Ave. becomes Mt. Vernon Ave.), cross over Bronx River and under train tracks, make first right onto "South West Street" #35 is the fourth building on the left. Our parking lot is on the left, after the tan brick building, and just before #35.

From Upper Westchester: Sprain Brook Pkwy (South) feeds into Bronx River Pkwy (South), take 1st exit after Cross County Pkwy, "Bronx River Road", (Left) at exit light onto Bronx River Road, (Left) at 2nd light, (Yonkers Ave. becomes

Mt. Vernon Ave.) cross over Bronx River and under train tracks, make first right onto "South West Street" #35 is the fourth building on the left. Our parking lot is on the left, after the tan brick building, and just before #35.

From Connecticut: Merit Pkwy/Hutchinson River Pkwy (South), exit "Cross County Pkwy" (West), to exit "Bronx River Pkwy" (South), 1st exit "Bronx River Road", (Left) at exit light onto Bronx River Road, (Left) at 2nd light, (Yonkers Ave. becomes Mt. Vernon Ave.), cross over Bronx River and under train tracks, make first right onto "South West Street" #35 is the fourth building on the left. Our parking lot is on the left, after the tan brick building, and just before #35.

NEW JERSEY

NJ Transit offers bus service to The Port Authority (visit www.panynj.gov for schedule information) and train service to Penn Station (visit http://www.transitcenter.com/transitguide/hub_nyp.htm for schedule information) from most parts of New Jersey. Grand Central Station offers direct train service via Metro North to our office.

The following bus routes will get you in to Port Authority:

The following train routes will get you in to Penn Station:

Northeast Corridor Line, North Jersey Coast Line, Gladstone Branch Line (including Morristown Line) and Montclair-Boonton Line.

Grand Central Station is located on 42nd Street, between Lexington and Madison Avenues. Train service to our office is available on The Harlem Line (blue) local trains to Mount Vernon WEST (usually North White Plains is the last stop for this route). Our office is located south of the train tracks, fully visible from the platform (red brick building).

WESTCHESTER, CONNECTICUT AND THE BRONX

Metro North offers train service all over Westchester County. MCP's headquarters are located on the Harlem Line (blue). If you live next to a Hudson or New Haven line train, you may need to transfer trains in White Plains.

The #7 Bee Line bus runs right by our office; please visit <http://beelinebus.westchestergov.com/timetables.htm> for route and schedule details.

QUEENS, BROOKLYN, STATEN ISLAND AND MANHATTAN

The best way to get to our office is from Grand Central Station. Please visit <http://www.mta.nyc.ny.us/nyct/service/> to get details on subway stops that are close to you or <http://www.mta.nyc.ny.us/nyct/bus/> to see which buses may work. From Grand Central Station, take a Harlem Line (blue) local train to Mount Vernon WEST. Our office is located south of the train tracks, fully visible from the platform (red brick building).

LONG ISLAND
